SHAPE THE LIGHT - Art for Light, Light for Art

- SHAPE-THE-LIGHT, a new European Project under the Creative Europe Programme CREA-CULT call for proposals, which brings together lighting, art and business, was launched on Monday, January 8th 2024.
- The consortium, led by the Italian <u>Cluster Rete di Imprese Luce in Veneto</u>, and with the collaboration of the Spanish <u>CICAT Cluster</u>, French <u>Cluster Lumière</u> and the <u>Catholic</u> <u>University of Leuven</u> from Belgium, starts today the project that will last 30 months.

Business, innovation and creativity are interrelated. SHAPE THE LIGHT is based on the dual complementary concept of the intrinsic relationships between art and business, focusing on art, design and the lighting industry.

The project will launch support initiatives and an open and inclusive collaborative space for the creation of new creative processes, business models and market developments, and to embrace the digital and ecological transition in the architectural lighting design sector.

The main objective is to create a bridge between the different agents in order to generate cocreation and co-design processes, launching opportunities to test advanced technologies and new innovative solutions to the challenges posed for these industries.

These support measures and collaborative spaces will trigger the creation of new creative processes and business models, driving the development of the lighting sector towards the proposals put forward in the European Green Deal and the priorities of the New European Bauhaus.

To support the European cultural and creative sectors in their digital transition and business recovery after the COVID-19 crisis.

SHAPE THE LIGHT will actively contribute to the objectives of the European Green Pact and the transition towards a sustainable and digital society by providing tangible opportunities and experiences, both at local and European level, for creation, co-design, experimentation, knowledge sharing and networking. Among the activities planned to achieve the objectives presented in the proposal, during the 30 months of the project we will find performance labs, coffees, masterclasses, workshops and forums, among others.
